CATEGORY SYSTEM (BS5837:2012 TREES IN RELATION TO CONSTRUCTION)

NOTE: THE CATEGORY SYSTEM IS INTENDED TO PROVIDE A RAPID REFERENCE AS TO THE PARTICULAR TREE(S) SUITABILITY FOR RETENTION AND CAN BE DEFINED AS FOLLOWS.

CATEGORY A TREES
TREES OF A HIGH QUALITY AND VALUE, THESE ARE TREES THAT ARE PARTICULARLY GOOD EXAMPLES OF THEIR SPECIES WHICH ALSO PROVIDE LANDSCAPE VALUE.

CATEGORY B TREES
TREE OF A MODERATE QUALITY AND VALUE, TREES THAT MIGHT BE INCLUDED IN THE HIGH CATEGORY BUT ARE DOWNGRADED BECAUSE OF IMPAIRED CONDITION. THESE TREES ARE IN SUCH A CONDITION TO MAKE A SIGNIFICANT CONTRIBUTION

CATEGORY C TREES
TREES OF LOW QUALITY AND VALUE, TREES THAT ARE IN ADEQUATE CONDITION TO REMAIN UNTIL NEW PLANTING COULD BE ESTABLISHED.

CATEGORY U TREES
TREES OF SUCH A CONDITION THAT ANY EXISTING VALUE WOULD BE LOST WITHIN 10 YEARS AND WHICH SHOULD IN THE CONTEXT BE REMOVED FOR THE REASONS OF SOUND ARBORICULTURAL MANAGEMENT.

TREES TO BE REMOVED DUE TO DEVELOPMENT PROPOSALS
